The Food System Council will ask the following questions and discuss them as a group when considering whether to consider or take action on a food system issue. The list is not exhaustive, but provides guidance for discussion.

- 1. Is there a direct connection between the issue and the FSC's vision, mission and strategies?
- 2. Is it an immediate issue that will have a major impact on the food system?
- 3. Is the issue urgent or time sensitive?
- 4. Does the issue build on or sustain an existing effort?
- 5. Can the FSC make a difference or influence the issue? What community are we trying to influence?
- 6. Does the FSC have the resources to commit to the issue?
- 7. Do we have enough information to decide?
- 8. What are the basic pieces of information we need to take this on?
- 9. Who else is working on the issue?

A quorum of Council members, which will consist of one-half of council plus one, need to be present for decisions to occur, with either the Chair or Vice-chair also present.
